We are pleased to announce that the Indian Society of International Law is conducting a Refresher Course in International Law for college and university teachers from 3<sup>rd</sup> September to 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2007 on behalf of the University Grants Commission (UGC). The topics for this refresher course are (i) Principles of Public International Law, (ii) Private International Law, (iii) Law of International Institutions, (iv) International Trade and Business Law, (v) International Human Rights and Humanitarian Law, (vi) International Criminal Law and (vii) International Environmental Law.

The Society is planning to invite experts of eminence in the field of international law to deliver lectures to the participants. The course will comprise classroom lectures, discussions, counselling and library consultation. Important study materials will be provided to the participants. The class will begin each day from 10 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. (6 hours a day) excluding Sunday and public holidays. The duration of each lecture – cum-discussion will be of 90 minutes. As you know the refresher programme is meant for the professional development of teachers. **Every participant has to pay an admission fee (non-refundable) of Rs.500.** The outstation participants will be paid 2nd class railway fare or by 1st class journey beyond 500 km over 12 hrs., whichever is less on production of railway tickets or any other documents in support of their claims. Rs.200/- will be paid to each outstation participant each day to cover their boarding/lodging expenditure. In case you wish us to arrange for boarding and lodging we will do so at approximately Rs. 200/- per person per day at guest houses which are near by to the Society.

Those who are interested to attend the Refresher Course should fill the application attached with this letter and send it to the Director of ISIL along with registration fee. Registration fee may be paid either by Cheque or Demand Draft in favour of “**The Indian Society of International Law, New Delhi**”. Those who want to pay the registration fee by Cheque should add Rs. 50 more for the service charge.
