ISIL 13th Winter Course on the Cyber Laws 26 December 2023 – 30 December 2023

The Indian Society of International Law (ISIL) was founded in 1959 at the initiative of Shri V. K. Krishna Menon and was inaugurated in the same year by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of independent India, with the objective to "foster nation-wide the study and development of International Law and to encourage the comparative study of the application of International Law in other States". The ISIL has been publishing *the Indian Journal of International Law* since its inception, which has attained a high standard and is held in high esteem the world over. The ISIL has also a good library, which is used by scholars from all over India. It organizes annual conferences and seminars on international issues of contemporary interest. Finally, and equally important, it conducts and promotes independent research on issues of International Law. The teaching wing of the ISIL- *the Indian Academy of International Law & Diplomacy* - runs post-graduate diploma courses in various branches of international law. The ISIL organises every year a Summer Course in international law to bring to you the current developments and their importance in the field.

From 2010 academic year, the ISIL organizes a one-week winter course every year on specific areas of international law viz., *International Environmental Law*, *International Trade Law*, *Private International Law*, *Trade and Investment Law*, *International Taxation Laws*, *Settlement of Dispute under International Law*, *International Maritime Law*, *International Migration and Refugee Law*, *International Law and National Security*, *Air and Space Law* and *Law of International Institutions*.

We are pleased to announce the **ISIL 13th Winter Course on Cyber Laws** which will commence from **Tuesday, 26 December 2023, to Saturday, 30 December 2023**. The topics will relate to international and national laws pertaining to cyber security, cyber-crimes, cyber operations, cyber warfare a broad range of issues such as today's threat landscape, approaches to sovereignty, data breaches, emerging cyber norms, interface with space laws, international humanitarian law, human rights, IPR and newly adopted Digital Data Protection Act. etc.

The Society endeavours to make available the best expertise available in the respective fields as course instructors, which would include noted academicians, governmental, non-governmental and UN officials etc.

The course will comprise classroom lectures, discussion, counseling and library consultation on weekdays. The course fee would be Rs. 3,000/- for students and Rs. 3,500/- for teachers and lawyers. Maximum 300 participants can be admitted on the basis of first-cum basis. Demand drafts shall be drawn in favour of the Indian Society of International Law. Online registration is also placed at ISIL website. At the end of the course a certificate of attendance will be given to all the participants.
