Recent armed conflicts have taken the lives of thousands of civilians and military personnel. In addition, a number of states are experiencing extreme levels of violence in internal conflicts, causing enormous destruction and deaths of a large number of innocent civilians. In these conflicts, the deliberate destruction of the natural environment, infrastructural religious and cultural property has also been reported. These conflicts have seen the use of Artificial Intelligence in military decision-making and weaponization of space; in addition to numerous violations of international humanitarian law (IHL), including the killing of journalists and humanitarian aid workers, use of prohibited weapons. Excessive use of explosive weapons and urban fighting across the world continues to cause immense suffering. These developments demand better understanding and research in IHL, which regulates the conduct in armed conflicts and mitigates the humanitarian impact of conflict.

This FDP will comprehensively cover the origin and development of International Humanitarian Law (IHL), Geneva Conventions and Additional Protocols, duties to respect these conventions, and classification of armed conflicts. It will also address the relationship of IHL with human rights law, and international criminal law; protection of the members of armed forces, prisoners of war, civilians (especially women and children), natural environment, cultural property, healthcare personnel, and media staff. Participants will explore prohibited means and methods of warfare, nuclear and new weapons, cyber warfare, autonomous weapons and the applicability of IHL in outer space. The discussions will further include artificial intelligence and IHL, War Crimes and the ICC, and national implementation mechanisms, providing a comprehensive understanding of IHL.

The Indian Society of International Law has designed a 7-days **ONLINE Faculty Development Programme** from **03-09 August 2026** for Teaching Faculties, PhD Scholars and LLM students. This programme will cover various topics to be discussed by experts in IHL.
